SECTION III. Agency Comments

When the sample period is multiplied by four to obtain the total estimated number of derivative classifications for FY 2014, there is a significant increase from 253 in FY 2013 to 448 during FY 2014. This is attributable to some changes in the Fraud Detection and National Security (FDNS) Directorate.

- 1. FDNS stood up the FDNS Employment Based (EB) -5 Division and a new Case Prioritization and Intelligence Assessment Branch within the Intelligence Division.
- 2. FDNS received additional Homeland Secure Data Network (HSDN) terminals enabling more frequent use of HSDN for derivative classification.

During FY 2014, USCIS created 1 Confidential, 102 Secret, and 9 Top Secret derivative documents during the sample period. There were a few reasons for the decrease during FY 2015:

- 1. Fraud Detection and National Security directorate personnel are using the shared drives more frequently instead of emailing information to the field.
- 2. More "Notice of Intelligence Concerns" were deemed to be releasable as unclassified information.
- 3. There was continued education about what constitutes a derivatively classified document.

SECTION III. Agency Comments

This year, USCIS saw an over 400% increase in derivative documents compared to FY 2015, when USCIS created (7) Confidential, (46) Secret and (0) Top Secret derivative documents during the sample period. There are a few reasons for the increase during FY 2016:

1. Fraud Detection and National Security Directorate had 3 times the number of Requests for Assistance from the field this year. During FY 2015, they only had 275 Case Analysis Threat Summary (CATS) reports, but so far this year, they have had 521. The increase is attributed to the FBI's recent change in the filters associated with name checks. This led to a sharp increase in the number of Letterhead Memoranda received by the field; each LHM automatically triggers the field to submit an RFA to FDNS Headquarters.

2. Continued education about what constitutes a derivatively classified information.
