This is a final response to your correspondence of 17 November 2016 requesting an Executive Order 12958, as amended, mandatory declassification review of SOVIET PLANS TO HAVE PLANE CARRYING POW'S FROM HANOI OVERLY (SIC) LAOS, AND TO ATTEMPT TO LIMIT ACCESS OF AMERICAN OFFICIALS IN RANGOON, dated 22 September 1972.

We completed a thorough search of our records and located the document responsive to your request. We have determined that the document may be released in sanitized form. We have deleted material that must remain classified on the basis of section 3.3(b)(1) of Executive Order 13526. Enclosed is a copy of the document showing our deletions and citing our exemption.

As the CIA Information and Privacy Coordinator, I am the CIA official responsible for this determination. You have the right to appeal this response to the Agency Release Panel, in my care, within 45 days from the date of this letter. Please include the basis of your appeal.
