Names, phones numbers and email addresses belong to third parties have been deleted in accordance with FOIA Exemption 6 (5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6)), which protects the personal privacy of persons mentioned in a government record by exempting information in personnel and medical files, as well as similar information in other files, that if disclosed to the requester, would result in a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

The above constitutes a partial denial of your request. It is made on behalf Lieutenant General James C. McConville, Deputy Chief of Staff, G-1. If you desire, you may appeal this partial denial within 60 days from the date of this letter.
