A review of New Orleans file 100-3091, entitled, in part, NATIONAL COUNCIL OF AMERICAN-SOVIET FRIENDSHIP, reflects that the American Council on Soviet Relations was first reported active in New Orleans during January, 1942. This group was reorganized in November, 1943, under the National Council of American-Soviet Friendship. An article appearing in the "New Orleans States" under date of Nov. 15, 1943, listed, among other prominent New Orleanians, Dr. ALTON OCHSNER as a sponsor of the local council of this organization. Who was a member of this organization and who has requested was also listed in the above-mentioned article as a sponsor, advised, as was set out in the report of ORIAN R. KENNEDY in instant file dated at New Orleans March 6, 1944, that he was not aware of his being listed as a sponson of the Aocal council of this organization, in that permission to use hishame low not been requested of him. He expressed the opinion that the ma Trity of the listed sponsors were probably in the same position ashe was fares their knowledge of their sponsorship of this organization was concerned.

made available to this diffice a copy of letter dated Feb. 16, 1944, addressed to him as a sponsor, from ROBERT D. FIELD, Chairman of this organization, requesting advice on raising sufficient funds to establish an office for the local council. This letter read, in part, "I have delayed writing to those who expressed their willingness to sponsor the organization since I made it clear when I asked for your cooperation that you would have no further obligation to the Council beyond the strengthening of our prestige in the community by the use of your name."

who requested his identity remain confidential, and who was also listed as a sponsor of the New Crleans Council of American-Soviet Friendship, in an interview with RICHARD L. WOELKER, SA, on Dec. 5, 1945, advised/ that although he favored peace between the American and Soviet governments he could not agree with some people who claimed that this country should

submit to any and all demands of the Russian government, and added that he believed that most of the other individuals who had become sponsors of this group shared his feelings in this matter.

Information in instant file reflects that as of Jan. 3, 1946 Dr. OCHSNER was still carried as a sponsor of the New Orleans council; however, articles appearing in the "New Orleans States" and other local newspapers, under date of Nov. 5, 1947, and subsequent dates, which articles set out a list of the current sponsors of this organization, did not include the name of Dr. OCHSNER.

The review of the New Orleans file on instant organization failed to reflect that Dr. OCHSNER took part in any of the activities of this group, other than as described above by the use of his name as a sponsor. The files of this office contain no other reference to this

Confidential informants of this office who are well acquainted with Communist Party membership and activities, as well as with the activities of the New Orleans Council of American-Soviet Friendship and other front organizations, were contacted and advised they knew of no activity on the part of employee indicating disloyalty to this country.

The offices of ONI and G-2 in New Orleans contain no record of Dr. OCHSNER.

The following background information concerning Dr. OCHSNER was obtained from the 1948-49 edition of "Who's Who in America" and from other reference sources:

Employee was born at Kimball, S. D. May 4, 1896. He obtained an A.B. Degree from the University of South Dakota in 1918 and an honorary degree as Doctor of Science from that institution in 1936; he graduated as a Doctor of Medicine from Washington University in 1920. On September 13, 1923 he married ISABEL KATHRYN LOCKWOOD and now is the father of 4 children. He interned at Barnes Hospital, St. Louis, Mo., 1920-21, and at the Augustana Hospital, Chicago, 1921-22; he served as exchange surgical assistant, Kantons Hospital, Zurich, Switzerland, 1922-23, at at Staedtisches Krankenhaus, Frankfurt an Main, Germany, 1923-24; as instructor in surgery, Northwestern University Medical School, 1925-26: as assistant professor of surgery, University of Wisconsin, 1926-27; as professor of surgery and head of the department of surgery, Tulane University, New Orleans, La., since 1927. He is now president of the Ochsner Clinic, Senior Surgeon, Touro Infirmary and consultant and visiting surgeon for various other hospitals in New Orleans. Dr. OCHSNER is a member of the Board of Regents, American College of Surgeons, former) president of the Southeastern Surgical Association (1942) and a member of the editorial staff of numerous medical journals.

On March 25, 1946 the "New Orleans Item" reported that Tr. OCHSNER had received a War Department citation for his patriotic service in connection with medical research. On Nov. 17, 1946 he was awarded the New Orleans "Times-Picayune" Loving Cup for 1915 "as the New Orleans citizen considered to have performed the greatest altruistic service for the community during that year", being selected by a committee named by the presidents of the Association of Commerce, the New Orleans Cotton Exchange and the New Orleans Board of Trade.

The records of the New Orleans Retail Credit Bureau, 140 Carondelet St., reflect Dr. OCHSNER has resided in New Orleans since 1925; that in addition to his income from the Ochsner Clinic he has a private practice of substantial proportions as well as income from considerable investments. His annual income, as estimated in 1947, was approximately 320,000.00. Reports of that bureau reflect his credit record as entirely satisfactory. He bears an excellent reputation as an eminent surgeon and prominent civic leader according to these records.

Br. EDWIN H. CARNES, Commanding Officer, U. S. Marine Hospital, New Orleans, advised he has known the employee for many years by reputation and as Consultant for that hospital for approximately 7 years, and that during that time no information had come to his attention indicating he was other than entirely loyal to the United States. Dr. CARNES stated that he did not consider Dr. OCHSNER to be a Government employee, inasmuch as he was employed by that hospital on a fee basis rather than on the regular payroll. The records of this hospital, however, as maintained by Personnel Clerk, reflect Dr. OCHSNER received an excepted appointment under U.S. Civil Service, whing his

The records of the New Orleans Police Department reflect no arrest of this employee.

The files of this Bureau contain information reflecting that the name of this applicant appeared in newspaper articles as a sponsor of the National Council of American-Soviet Friendship, an organization named by the Atterney General as within the purview of Executive Order 1050.

In view of the foregoing information an inquiry was conducted concerning this applicant and it was ascertained that the American Council on Soviet Relations was first reported active in New Orleans, Louisiana, during January, 1942. The group was reorganized in November, 1943, under the National Council of American-Soviet Friendship. An article appearing in the "New Orleans States," newspaper under the date of November 15, 1943, listed among other prominent New Orleanians, Dr. Alton Ochsner as a spensor of the local council of the organization. One individual who was a member of the organization and who was also listed in the above-mentioned article as a sponsor advised that he was not aware of his being listed as a sponsor of the local council of the organization, and that permission to use his name had not been requested of him. He expressed the opinion that/the majority of the listed sponsors were possibly in the


same position as he was insofar as their knowledge of their sponsorship of this organization was concerned.

Another individual who was also listed as a sponsor of this council advised that although he favored peace between the American and Soviet Governments, he could not agree with some people who claimed that this country should submit to any and all demands of the Russian Government, and he added that he believed that most of the other individuals who had become sponsors of this group shared his feelings in this matter.

Information was received that as of January 3, 1946, Dr. Ochsner was still carried as a sponsor of the New Orleans Council; however, articles appearing in the "New Orleans States" and other local newspapers under date of November 5, 1947, and subsequent dates, setting out a list of the current sponsors of this organization, did not include the name of Dr. Ochsner. Further inquiry failed to reflect that Dr. Ochsner took part in any of the activities of this group, other than as described above the use of his name as a sponsor.

Confidential informants of the New Orleans Office who are well acquainted with Communist Party membership and activities in the New Orleans area as well as with the activities of the New Orleans Council of American-Soviet Friendship and other front organizations, were contacted and advised they knew of no activities on the part of Dr. Ochsner indicating disloyalty to this country. Additional inquiry revealed that on March 25, 1946, the "New Orleans Item " newspaper reported that Dr. Ochsner had received a citation for his patriotic services in connection with medical research. On November 17, 1946, he was awarded the New Orleans "Times-Picayune." newspaper Loving Cup for 1945 "as the New Orleans citizen considered to have performed the greatest altruistic service for the community during that year," his having been selected by a civic committee named by the presidents of the Association of Commerce, the New Orleans Cotton Exchange, and the New Orleans Board of Trade. Additional inquiry reflected that Dr. Ochsner bears an excellent reputation in New Orleans as an eminent surgeon and prominent civic leader. In view of the above an investigation of this applicant is not being conducted under Executive Order 10450 in the absence of a specific request.
