This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of September 14, 2013, which was received in this office on September 16, 2013. Your request has been assigned case number **RD 41299**. You requested access to Federal Bureau of Investigation Headquarters Case File 94-HQ-52161 regarding Herbert Kaplow. This file is part of Record Group 65, Records of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (location: 230/83/48/7, box 494).

We located the file, which consists of 22 pages and covers the period from 1953 through 1975. The main subject of the file is Herbert Kaplow.

We have completed our review of this file, totaling 22 pages. We have determined that 12 pages may be released in full. Two pages may be released with portions redacted under exemptions (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C) of the Freedom of Information Act (5 USC 552). Exemption (b)(6) exempts the release of information that could cause an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. Exemption (b)(7)(D) exempts the release of information that could reveal the identity of a confidential law enforcement informant. Eight pages (one two-page document, consisting of four copies) have been withheld under exemption (b)(1), which exempts the release of classified information.

We have enclosed courtesy photocopies of the redacted file for your convenience. The withheld documents are represented by a withdrawal notice. If you have any questions regarding the processing of your request, you may contact Mary Kay Schmidt by email at marykay.schmidt@nara.gov.

If you consider this an adverse response, you may appeal, in writing, within 35 days of the date of this letter. 



Herbert Kaplow has not been the subject of an investigation conducted by the FBI. However, our files reveal the following information which may pertain to him.

Information was received during 1965 that a passport for travel to Cuba had been issued on July 16, 1965, at Washington, D. C., to Herbert Elias Kaplow, a reporter for NBC. Kaplow was born on February 2, 1927, at New York, New York, and at that time resided at Falls Church, Virginia. His parents were identified as Solomon Kaplow, born in Russia in 1888, and Belle Bernstein Kaplow, born in Russia in 1896, both of whom were United States citizens. Kaplow was married to Betty Rae Kaplow, who was born in twas further stated that Kaplow had been in Cuba several times, most recently in 1961, to cover the visit of the Russian cosmonaut, Major Yuri Gagarin, to Cuba. The central files of the FBI contain no additional pertinent information concerning him.

SUBJECT: NAME CHECKS ON NEWS COMMENTATORS

In D. J. Brennan, Jr., to Mr. W. C. Sullivan memorandum dated 11-19-69, it was noted that on the morning of 11-19-69, Mr. Egil Krogh, Jr., Deputy Assistant to the President for Domestic Affairs, and Larry Higbee of his staff advised the Liaison Agent that the President had requested on an urgent basis all biographic data and any information in the Bureau files concerning the principal television personalities on the three major networks. Krogh and Higbee requested specifically information on the following names as well as any other television personalities of similar rank: John Chancellor, Roger H. Mudd, Eric Sevareid, Howard K. Smith, Sander Vanocur, Chet Huntley, David Brinkley, Walter Cronkite, Frank McGee, Frank Reynolds, William H. Lawrence, and Herbert Kaplow.

A survey was immediately made of all reference sources in the news media field available to this Section to ascertain additional commentators of similar rank. As a result of this survey of reference material and knowledgeable individuals in the Crime Records Division, the following were considered pertinent and were also included in the list of name checks made for the White House: Martin Agronsky, Bill Downs, Jr., Peter Sidney Hackes, Joseph C. Harsch, Marvin Kalb, and Edward P. Morgan. It is noted that in none of the reference material available was Frank Kearns, CBS, listed. The news release by Alice Widener of the U.S.A. Syndicate concerning Frank Kearns and his biased handling of the Rafael Minichiello hijack case was not available when the project was started. Even though Frank Kearns would not be in the category of "principal television personalities on the three major networks" and even though he is not listed in any television reference books as having any official high rank, it is felt that the White House would be interested in this story by Alice Widener.

The central files of the FBI reflect no information identifiable with a Frank Kearns, CBS correspondent in Rome, Italy, and no arrest record was located identifiable with him. Although he is not of similar rank to the names furnished us by the White House, it is felt the news release concerning his biased and prejudiced action would be of interest to the White House.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the attached letter to Mr. Egil Krogh, Jr., concerning

Frank Kearns be sent.

He explained that he had come through Puerto Rico in connection with another matter inasmuch as he is en route to Cape Canaveral where he will be at work with respect to a forthcoming space launching matter, and that during his stopover in Puerto Rico he had been asked by his headquarters to look into the matter of a possible new anti-CASTRO movement planning military action against Cuba. It was explained to him that we were familiar with the news story to which he made reference, and it appeared that the sources for the story were in Florida and other parts of the United States. There was no further discussion of the matter.

Foregoing is for information of the Bureau inasmuch as KAPLO indicated he has been personally acquainted with Bureau executives at the Seat of Government over a period of years.

Herb Kaplow called SA Charles E. Moore, Jr., in Crime Records late yesterday and wanted material on Garrison, our most recent "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives." This information was sent to him by special messenger and he indicated it would becarried on the Morgan Beatty show March 5.

During the latter fifteen minutes of his broadcast,
Beatty gave a highly dramatic presentation regarding the FBI's
"Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" program. He characterized Ed
Garrison as the "mathematical wizard" and went into considerable
detail regarding his background and certain of his characteristics.
The program handled Frank Sprenz as well, and Sprenz was typified
as the "ivy league hot rodder." Between the mention of these fugitives,
Beatty did a build up on one John Monciato described as the "tattooed
sailor" wanted by the New York police in connection with the death of
Arnold Schuster.

This was a well-planned fifteen minute dramatization with frequent mention of the FBI and our "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" program.
