advised that on 2/23/86 he was introduced to

claims to be in contact with certain psychic forces that provide her with higher information on selected subjects. She refers to these forces as "Source" and when providing information from Source she often speaks in the collective "we". claimed that she had come to Washington, D.C. to provide information concerning the Challenger space shuttle explosion on 1/28/86.

On 2/24/86; was debriefed by concerning the information she wished to reveal. The enclosed audio tape is a record of that entire session and is self explanatory. It should be noted that this session and can be heard making comments and asking questions toward the end of the tape. The following points are emphasized by during the course of the debriefing:

CON DENTIAL



- (A) The space shuttle explosion was not the result of a technical malfunction. Rather, it was an act of sabotage perpetrated by a terrorist organization.
- (B) There were three saboteurs on the scene at Cape Canaveral. These included two ground crewmen and one of the astronauts who died in the explosion.
- (C) The terrorist organization is a Japanese based fanatical group with an ancestral lineage and a deep seated hatred toward the United States. Its motivation in destroying the shuttle was to embarrass and discredit the United States and to impede the progress of the space program.
- (D) The three saboteurs were all of oriental heritage. They were apparently recruited by the terrorist organization after their employment by NASA.
- (E) The explosion was effected by a device placed inside the external fuel tank of the shuttle. An individual whose description seems to match that of an engineer or technician placed this charge. The charge was triggered by a second saboteur using a hand-held transmitter while standing in the crowds watching the shuttle liftoff. This individual matches the description of a guard or security person.
- (F) The astronaut saboteur chose to die in the explosion as a sort of ritual death or "cleansing".
- (G) The descriptions of the saboteurs provided by are probably complete enough to pinpoint the individuals. Although names and addresses are not available, in the case of the "guard" pinpointed his residence on a 1:24,000 scale topographical map of an area of Florida near Cape Canaveral (enclosed). She also provided a description of his physical appearance as well as his life style. While actual names are difficult for Source to acquire claims she could easily identify the saboteurs from a list of names if NASA could provide one.

(H) claims that Source's motivation in revealing this information is to assure the United States that its space program is a safe undertaking and that there is no major technical flaw in the shuttle equipment. Further claims that Source is concerned about possible lengthy delays in the progress of the space program that will allow other nations to surge shead appreciated that wreckage of the shuttle will be found within the next several days that will support the sabotage allegation.

advised WFO that although previously unknown to him, appeared to be a rational, intelligent and articulate individual who was sincere in her claims and beliefs. He further stated that is willing to work with any responsible investigative body concerning this matter.

was advised by WFO that the foregoing information would be reported in appropriate Bureau channels in an expeditious manner. He was also encouraged to make the information available to the President's Commission investigating the shuttle explosion contacted the Commission on 2/26/86 and later reported to WFO that the Commission is interested in the information and has requested a full transcript of the audio tape.

Above is provided to the Bureau and the Tampa Division for their information. WFO is not in a position to make any recommendation in this matter. Dissemination of the information to the Commission investigating the shuttle incident is left to Bureau and Tampa Discretion.

PRESIDENTIAL COMMISSION ON THE SPACE SHUTTLE "CHALLENGER"

On 3/3/86 the Director told me of a telephone call he had received requesting the FBI to provide Special Agents to assist the Commission in its inquiry. The Director said that we may offer the assistance of four Special Agents for not longer than 90 days and requested me to call Peter Rostoven, Counsel to the Commission, at telephone number 453-1405.

At 2:17 p.m. on 3/3/86, I called Peter Rostoven who told me that Special Agents were needed to assist the Commission teams to review evidence collected. He said that our Agents would not be used for witness interviews because of the Commission's concern that it not appear that a criminal investigation is being conducted. I asked Mr. Rostoven to be more specific as to what duties our Agents would be requested to perform. He said he did not know but that he would request the Executive Director, Dr. Alton Keel, to call me to describe their needs.

At 2:52 p.m. on March 3rd, Bill McGuiness at telephone number 633-2268 called me and said that the Attorney General's office had received a request from the President's Commission to have FBI Agents assist in their investigation. Mr. McGuiness said this matter was referred to him to handle in the Attorney General's office but that he was calling me to refer the matter directly to the FBI and he would defer to the FBI for the decision. He did request that he be notified of any arrangements that might be made.

At 3:45 p.m. on March 3rd, I called the Administrative Services Division and in the absence of Mr. Sharp instructed Tom Hughes to begin making arrangements for the detailing of up to four Agents for not more than 90 days to the Presidential Commission.

At 10:37 a.m. on March 4th, Emily Trapnell, attorney, President's Commission, 453-1405, located at Suite 760, Capital Gallery Building, 600 Maryland Avenue, Southwest, Washington, D.C., called me and said that she had discussed the request for PBI Agent assistance with Dr. Al Keel, the Executive Director, and he had requested her to coordinate arrangements with the FBI. She said she formerly was the Special Assistant to the Chief Counsel at FAA and that Peter Rostoven is handling the broad legal issues for the Commission while she is handling the coordination of the investigation. She said they presently have several military and FAA investigators assigned to the four panels into which the Commission was divided. She said they now have a need for special investigative expertise to "close some loops." She said they need our Agents to conduct one-on-one interviews that will be penetrating and that will compare existing testimony with statements being given by witnesses. She said that some of the people to be interviewed are NASA employees but that some are contractor-type personnel. She said it is very important that the Commission not appear to be conducting a criminal investigation and they do not want to seem to be looking for culpability in their interviews. She said they do not want to intimidate any of the witnesses. Rather, they would like for those interviewed to be encouraged to come forward and furnish full information and even suggest "what else we need to think about. " She said for example that there is a critical telephone conversation in which there had been 30 participants in several locations. Ten of these persons have testified and the Commission would like to have complete statements from all of them. She said that their immediate need is to have two Special Agents by the end of this week. There will be some travel involved in the inquiries and she mentioned Utah, Huntsville, Alabama, and Florida as places where interviews may need to be conducted.

Emily Trapnell said that their longer term needs for two other Agents are to review certain records and letters where people have voluntarily contributed information which may contain some evidence.

She said that the persons selected should be able to put aside their "FBI-person" and take on a "Commission-person" identity.

I told Ms. Trapnell that I would make the appropriate arrangements and return her call.

The Agents designated will report to Emily Trapnell at the address given above. Emily Trapnell said that the service of the investigators would be nonreimbursable as to the salaries of the Agents but that NASA would pay all expenses of their service.

I will keep you advised and upon completion of the arrangements I will notify Bill McGuiness in the Attorney General's office.

The following information will serve as an update concerning the assignment of four Special Agents to the Presidential Commission on the Space Shuttle "Challenger."

The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) has conducted numerous investigations regarding information received, subsequent to the shuttle Challenger explosion, concerning possible sabotage of the space craft. These investigations are synopsized as follows:

On January 27, 1986, an anonymous caller made a telephone call to Channel 7 News, a CBS-TV affiliate, Boston, Massachusetts, and stated "some horrible, horrible things were going to happen tomorrow, at least five people are going to be killed." The caller indicated he was one of a group of three that was going to sabotage NASA. The caller further indicated that if the shuttle did blow up he would recontact the news station. On January 28, 1986, at approximately 3:25 p.m. the anonymous caller made a telephone call to Channel 7 News and advised that he intended to make a telephone call to the Governor at 5:00 p.m. During a briefing of Agents in the Boston Office of the FBI, it was recalled that in September, 1985, a "walk in" complainant, of questionable mental capacity, had indicated he had been responsible for the delay of previous shuttle flights, plane crashes, and other catastrophic events. It was determined that the complainant's name was The anonymous caller made a telephone call to residence at 5:00 p.m., as previously indicated, and gave the name was to meet him. Further investigation by the FBI reflected that tamper-proof seals are placed on the ODU prior to being sent to the environmental laboratory for testing. Examination of the seals determined that tampering with the ODU once it left the production

On January 30, 1986, the FBI Office in Cleveland, Ohio, was telephonically contacted by the phonon was telephon , who advised that on October 18, 1985, he had a casual conversation with at Cape Canaveral former NASA During their conversation about the shuttle craft propulsion system solid fuel booster rockets, described the working conditions at NASA in Florida as "bad," which generated pressures on the NASA staff. something went wrong with the snuttle while it was in the air, NASA stated that if could destroy it, and it's going to happen in the near future. related to that someone at NASA in Florida had a bad attitude, but was smart with computers. didn't elaborate on this statement. was interviewed by the FBI and he stated he recalled saying something to friends in Cleveland about his concern for safety at Kennedy Space Center, and his personal opinion that a tragedy could occur. He explained he was never comfortable working around the fuel cells for the solid rocket boosters, and he was concerned that one of the cells might ignite and melt down the Vertical Assembly Building. never aware of any specific violations, shortcuts, negligence, or misconduct by NASA employees. He stated that type of conduct would not have been tolerated. did not have any information regarding sabotage or potential sabotage at NASA. No further FBI investigation is being conducted regarding this matter.

The FBI received information regarding reports by two psychics who reported the shuttle exploded because of sabotage.

One of these psychic reports was specific enough to allow for limited FBI investigation, which met with negative results.

On January 31, 1986, the FBI Resident Agency in Santa Ana, California, was advised by that he believes the Challenger exploded due to its being struck by laser beams fired from either Cuba or an aircraft. Stated that a review of film footage of the explosion revealed brown puffs of smoke coming from the space shuttle just prior to the explosion. He stated leaks from the fuel tanks would produce white smoke, not brown smoke. Stated that the brown smoke would be produced each time the craft took a "hif" by the laser beam, and the explosion occurred when the laser beam penetrated the skin of the craft.






