



Synopsis: Recommendation that WILLIAM FRANCIS BUCKLEY segment of the LEBNAP investigation be separated from that case file and a new 256 file established and assigned to the writer.

Classification: This document is classified "SECRET" in its entirety unless otherwise marked.

Details: WILLIAM FRANCIS BUCKLEY, Chief of Station, U.S. CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY (CIA), Beirut, Lebanon, was kidnapped in the vicinity of his residence in West Beirut, Lebanon, on March 16,1984.

On October 4, 1985, the ISLAMIC JIHAD, an underground splinter group of HEZBOLLAH, announced that BUCKLEY had been executed; labeling the action a response to an Israeli military strike against the PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZATION (PLO) in Tunisia. Information secured from various sources, to include that gleaned from American newspapers, led to certain speculation

that BUCKLEY had been housed and interrogated in Lebanon, Syria and finally Tehran, Iran, during his captivity. BUCKLEY is believed to have died of a heart attack in a Tehran hospital following prolonged torture.

The BUCKLEY investigation has been subsumed within the LEBNAP major case file from its inception. The investigation should be afforded separate case status:

(1) Of the LEBNAP victims, BUCKLEY was the single individual living in Beirut as a result of a U.S. Government assignment.

(2) Unlike the other LEBNAP victims and, according to informed speculation by American newspapers, the BUCKLEY abduction precipitated an extensive and costly effort by CIA in his behalf.

(The FBI has not been given access to any information developed as a result of this effort).

(3) To be afforded a proper investigative effort the BUCKLEY file data must be separated from the administrative morass that is LEBNAP.

(4) Recently developed information (see LEBNAP for (S) suggests the existence of substantial new lead information.

It is recommended that the BUCKLEY investigation be separated, administratively, from the LEBNAP case file and assigned to the writer.






