

Departmental Attorney Thelton Henderson. Departmental Attorney Henderson subsequently submitted his resignation which was accepted. Some editorial comments were as follows: "If the Justice Department does not know what its own people are doing, in this case, what certainty is there that it knows what others are doing?" "If it is not able to rely on what its own personnel tell it, how capable is it in inquiring into activities of others?" "Easy rolling of one head will not silence questioning." "The Justice Department has not satisfactorily explained how this kind of thing could have come about in the first place, or its inability to rely on its own people. The Justice Department is expected by all citizens to be immaculate. It is not."





As a result of surveillance of suspect Robert Chambliss on his recent business trip, an auto parts dealer at Tallassee, Alabama, advised he had obtained a used 1942 Hudson clutch assembly as a trade-in about one year ago and that this assembly was kept in the storeroom until about a month and a half ago when it was set aside as trash by a salesman for an auto rebuilt parts company during a sales contact. The disposition and location of this clutch assembly is not known to the dealer. The auto parts dealer is regularly contacted by Chambliss, delivery man for an auto rebuilt parts company. Chambliss makes delivery and picks up used parts to be reconditioned and for credit allowance.

The clutch assembly as described by the auto parts. dealer is similar or identical to clutch parts used in the shrapnel bomb used at 16th Avenue and Center Street, South in Birmingham, Alabama, on September 25, 1963. Intensive efforts are being made to prove or disprove this clutch assembly as part of the bomb.

#### APPENDIX

## NATIONAL STATES RIGHTS PARTY (NSRP)

On November 26, 1957, a source advised that the United White Party (UWP) was organized at a convention held in Knoxville, Tennessee, on November 10, 1957. An article in the November 26, 1957 issue of the "Greenville Piedmont," a newspaper of Greenville, South Carolina, reported "the recent formation of a new political party to be known as the United White Party." According to the article, the party was formed at a recently held meeting in Knoxville, Tennessee at which many klansmen were represented. The UWP was reported as being opposed to all "race mixing organizations and individuals."

The July 1958 issue of "The Thunderbolt", self. described as the "official Racial Nationalist Organ of the National States Rights Party" (NSRP) reported that rank and file "States Righters" had merged with the UWP under "the banner of the National States Rights Party," with national offices at Post Office Box 261, Jeffersonville, Indiana.

In November 1958, a source advised that the NSRP is composed of past members of klan-type organizations and notorious anti-Semites.

Issue Number 19, dated June 1960, "The Thunder-bolt", announced the address of the headquarters of the NSRF had been changed from Jeffersonville, Indiana to Post Office Box 783, Birmingham, Alabama.

On June 17, 1960 a source advised that Edward R. Fields, the Information Director of the NSRP, is the individual who "runs the NSRP."

"The Thunderbolt" continues to publish articles attacking Negroes and persons of the Jewish faith.

and retailed to advise me that Special Agents and retailed to appear in State Court tomorrow, November 14, 1963, in connection with the arrest of one Jerry Dutton by the local police, Oct. 30, 1963.

It is recalled that Agents and went to the National States Rights Party (NSRP) headquarters in connection with running out a lead in this case and two of Dr. Edward Fields' associates (Fields is head of the NSRP) were at his headquarters where he also maintains a residence. Dutton started a tirade against the two Agents' being communist and generally engaged in the kind of talk which NSRP has put out about Negroes, FBI, and so forth. Dutton was previously arrested for having possession of a gun.

When the Agents inquired as to whether Dr. Fields was available, Dutton started the above tirade and told both of them they were in violation of the trespass laws and they were going to call the local police. The Agents suggested that if they desired to do so this was their prerogative. After waiting for some time the police came. Dr. Fields also entered his home and the Agents were in a position to hear Dutton call the police, at which time Dutton advised the police that there were two communists at the house and they wanted these fellows arrested for trespass. When the police arrived, Dutton was arrested for making a false call to the police department furnishing false information. The Agents were in a position to clearly indicate that they heard Dutton make the call and would be glad to testify to this and so advised the local police department. The Agents, of course, acted properly, stood their ground, and were not pushed around by a couple of psychopathic punks. The fact that it ended up that Dutton was arrested indicates that the proper action was taken.

This case will be heard tomorrow, November 14, 1963, and the Agents will testify that they were at Fields' home in connection with an official inquiry and will relate the incidents which occurred above.



It has also been learned that a lawyer representing Dutton, one Matt Murphy, apparently has taken Dutton, James Warner, Dr. Fields, and Estora Malone (Dr. Fields' secretary) to local Clerk of the Court where a complaint apparently has been sworn out charging the two Agents, and with "trespass after warning" and "disorderly conduct." This apparently is an attempt on their part to take retributive action against the two Agents. They have not been served. It appears that tomorrow they probably will be served with this complaint when they appear in local court.

This matter will be taken up with the United States Attorney in the event the Agents are served and steps will be taken to get this case into Federal Court. You will be advised of further developments.

the NSRP Attorney, has been characterized by fellow attorneys as "run-of-the-mill" with a predominently criminal and divorce practice. He is separated from his wife and is reputed to be a heavy drinker.

They have

agreed to submit to polygraph examination. Numerous other present and past members of the Eastview Klavern were also interviewed on 11/14/63, but furnished no information of value.


Further attempts to trace the source of dynamite used by and two associates in the Alabama Klans in a 1958 bombing in Birmingham were made on 11/14/63, but no information of value was developed. This inquiry, which has included interviews of individuals who were members of the Alabama Klans during that period, is continuing in an effort to determine if the source of the dynamite used in 1958 bombing is involved in the recent Birmingham bombings.



> In connection with the instant investigation, the assignment of personnel is being re-evaluated as development of occur. In this regard, we have released five Special Agents and based on the present workload, it is possible to release an additional five by the close of business this week. One of the five was released yesterday in view of a subpoena and he is not being returned to this assignment but will return to his office of assignment.

Four of the eight clerical personnel have been released to their respective offices. This will be carefully examined in the next ten-day period and further recommendations will be made with reference to the personnel presently assigned. It is noted that we have reduced our Special Agent personnel by approximately thirty per cent and have reduced our clerical personnel on special assignment by fifty per cent. In view of the continuing activity, no further reduction can be made; however, this will be re-evaluate within a ten-day period and appropriate recommendations will be submitted to the Director.

One avenue which appears to be productive of results may be forthcoming following the plan to submit to the local authorities any possible local violations. This could have a salutary effect on several of the suspects which so far are aware of our interest in them but who have as yet not broken.

Another possible local violation being pursued vigorously at this time is the investigation relating to the information that another suspect

We are trying to get corroboration of this attack and appropriate steps are being taken to this end. It is possible that this could be prosecuted by local authorities, and if sufficient information is developed, it will be presented at the appropriate time.

This type of activity will be continued as well as any other means of inquiry in order to continue to maintain a constant awareness in the minds of all suspects that this matter is being pursued. We have repeated instances where this type of activity is showing its effect and some of the individuals are becoming emotionally upset because of it which would indicate that this is one of the effective approaches which we are presently utilizing.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

If approved by the Director, it is planned to have the additional five Agents (inclusive of the Agent released yesterday) return to their office of assignment by the close of business this week. The matter of personnel will be re-evaluated within ten days and appropriate recommendations submitted. If circumstances change in the meantime, you will be immediately advised.






