A source advised on October 25, 1963, that in December, 1960, a group was organized at Shreveport, Louisiana, known as the Original Knights of the Ku Klux Klan (OKKKK). The purpose of this organization was to promote Americanism, white supremacy, and the maintaining of segregation.

This source further advised on October 25, 1963, that the OKKKK continues to be active and that the aims and purposes continue to be the same.

### WHITE KNIGHTS OF THE KU KLUX KLAN OF MISSISSIPPI

A source advised that on February 15, 1964, approximately 200 members of the Original Knights of the Klux Klan (OKKKK) from the State of Mississippi met at ambokhaven, Mississippi. Those present decided to defect from the OKKKK and to form their own klan group in Mississippi to be known as the White Knights of the Ru Klux Klan of Mississippi.

This source advised that the aims and purposes of the White Knights of the Ku Klux Klan of Mississippi are to preserve Christian civilization, protect and promote white supremacy and the segregation of the races, to fight communism and to extend the dignity, heritage and rights of the white race of America.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

He is running out the sources of the clocks used as timing devices, the dynamite caps and contemplates interviewing 180 employees of the mine from which it is believed the dynamite was stolen. is also very alert to develop any indication that these two cases are tied into the bombing of the Sixteenth Street Baptist Church in September, 1963. Additionally, the Bureau instructed to have all Klansmen and members of hate groups interviewed for the purpose of developing any information showing the activities of members of such groups in violence in the past, including the cases under investigation, and any contemplated violence or demonstrations opposing the civil rights movement. It is noted that about 45 automobiles from the Birmingham Bessemer area took part in the Ku Klux Klan demonstration in Montgomery on March 21, 1965, thus showing active participation in Klan activities.

Memorandum to Mr. Tolson RE: GREENBOMB AND RELATED CASES

I talked to Inspector Sullivan at Selma, Alabama, bearing in mind that we had sent Agents in to Selma on special assignment to assist in covering the march from Selma to Montgomery on March 21-25, 1965. Sullivan has a number of special matters under investigation including the shooting of Jimmy Jackson by a state trooper on February 18, 1965, at Marion; the march at Selma on March 7, 1965, where troopers and the sheriff's posse used tear gas and clubs to disperse the march; the killing of Reverend Rebb on March 9, 1965; the dispersal of demonstrators at Montgomery by unnecessary force on March 16, 1965; leads from the murder of Mrs. Liuzzo on March 25, 1965; and the coverage of continuing demonstrations at the Selma area. Sullivan said these investigations are coming along well, he is getting results down in report form and while there is considerable additional investigation in some of these cases, he is now at the point where he can start releasing men. He has a total of 70 men, approximately 50 of whom are on special assignment. He can release 30 of these men starting Monday morning, March 29, 1965. I told him to have these 30 men together with 15 automobiles report at Birmingham, Monday morning or as soon as possible thereafter. Sullivan said he can release additional men probably by the end of next week and he will keep us advised.

I advised Inspector that 30 men and 15 cars would report to him unless advised to the contrary starting Monday morning, March 29, 1965, and that he should check with Inspector Sullivan to see if Sullivan could likewise release 3 stenographers and a clerk to come to Birmingham. If Sullivan cannot release the clerical personnel is to recontact the Bureau.

I told both Inspector and Inspector Sullivan that the Department is thinking in terms of an early Grand Jury and a Departmental Attorney is going down to Montgomery this weekend to lay the groundwork. The Department is interested in the cases we are investigating and also the activities of the Ku Klux Klan and other hate groups. I told them that we do not want incomplete investigative results furnished to the attorneys; that we want the investigations reduced to report form and sent into the Bureau and thereafter we will clear these reports for delivery to the attorneys at the scene. For this reason, it is essential that the investigations be completed promptly and reduced to report form promptly.
