Alleged Alliance of Cuban Refugee Organizations

By the end of February 1962 Mr. Mario BRIGLIA had signed 15 to 20 action groups into a confederation of exile organizations to work toward the overthrow of the Castro Government. Briglia, President of the MAR (Movimiento Accion Recuperadora) was the moving force in the campaign to form a loose united front of exile groups called "Union Revolucionaria" which agrees:

- a. To take the war to Cuba.
- b. To refrain from attacking internally other political groups
- c. To put themselves at the disposal of the US Government for action.
- d. To attempt to draw up an alliance with Consejo Revolucionario and other organizations.
