Information on Seven Cuban Internal Resistance Groups

Information provided us by our internal assets and Cuban ex-filtrates indicate that seven groups opposing Castro are making efforts to consolidate into one unified resistance. A brief description of the groups follows:

a. Movimiento de Recuperacion Revolucionario (MRR): The primary strength of this group lies in the Havana area, the Santa Clara area, and certain areas of Pinar del Rio. Its militant membership numbers 175. Communication with this group is maintained through one W/T circuit and SW communications. The leader of this group, one OMAR, is presently in the United States and is about to return to Cuba. In his absence, ESTEAN is the acting leader. Although in the past we provided this group with equipment, money, radio operators and trained specialists, we have recently only been able to get 1500 pounds of material into them. However, we are presently attempting to infiltrate two radio sets to this group and backstopping their procurement of operational funds locally through deposits made to donor accounts in the United States. This group gives the most promise for effective operations and has a potential for sabotage, propaganda and intelligence activity. Externally, the principal representatives are Rafael Aurelio QUINTERO (the OMAR) and Juan Manuel GUILLOT. The MRRL faction of the original MRR contains as external leaders Ricardo LORIE and Nino DIAZ.

b. Movimiento Revolucionario del Pueblo (MRP): The primary strength of this group lies in the Havana and Las Villas areas. Its militant membership is approximately 150. We no longer have W/T Communications, but must rely on couriers for communication with this group. The group is not yet reorganized internally to an extent sufficient to involve itself in operations of note. The group's representative has recently come to the United States, and the current internal leader is one ANTONIO. Manolo Ray was formerly the external representative of this group. Externally its principal representatives are Rogelio CISNEROS, Ignacio MENDOZA, and Marcos WILLIAMS. Ray and his former chief associate Col. Barquin, Pazos, Chibas are not closely associated with the present active elements of one MRP with whom we are in contact.

c. United Revolucionaria (UR): This group is composed of some thirty small factions with the primary strength resident in the provinces of Oriente, Matanzas, Havana, and Pinar del Rio with the possibility of some few people remaining in the Escambray Mountains of Las Villas. We no longer have W/T communications with this group; the former radio operator was captured. In August of 1961, of its leaders, CESAR was reported to be captured and JUSTO took asylum and is presently in the United States. Present internal leadership is RICARDO. Communications with this internal group will have to be re-established via the use of a courier as soon as feasible. Externally

Its principal representatives are Alberto PERNANDEZ Echavarria, Andres Zayas, and Cesar Brito.

d. Movimiento Democratico Cristiano (MDC): The primary strength of this group resides in the Oriente and Matanzas areas, although they have some representation in Havana and Pinar de Rio provinces. This group employs sound security practices in its activity to a greater degree than any of the other opposition elements in Cuba. The former group leader Lucas PERNANDEZ Badue is presently in the United States; the current internal leader is Alberto del JUNCO MESA. Contact is maintained with this group via SW means. Although its activity has been limited, this element has the potential for the conduct of resistance, sabotage and intelligence activities. The MDC is a Catholic labor organization numbering approximately 100 members within Cuba. PERNANDEZ, their present external coordinator, is currently undergoing training. The former external leader of the MDC was Jose Ignacio RASCO.

e. 30th of November Group: This is a small labor group numbering approximately fifty. The organizer of this group, one DAVID SALVADOR, has been in prison in Havana for some time. The current internal leader is one BENITO. We have courier communications with this element which is believed to have a good potential for sabotage operations. Externally, the leadership of this group is in doubt.

where three individuals are competing for control: JESUS PERNANDEZ, CARLOS RODRIGUEZ QUESADA, and ANDRES CARRILLO MENDOZA.

f. Rescate Democratico Revolucionario (RDR): One of the groups forming the Democratic Revolutionary Front (FRD) and the subsequent Cuban Revolutionary Council (CRC). They are believed to number twenty-five, and have a limited capability for paramilitary and propaganda activities. The only communications existent with this group is by means of courier. The true external representation of this group is somewhat confused since ALBERTO CRUZ, exfiltrated by the CNR to represent the element was replaced by MENDEZ PEREZ at the direction of ANTONIO VARONA of the FRD in Miami. VARONA is the titular head of the Rescate.

g. Directorio Revolucionario Estudiantel (DRE): This student group, which engages in hemispheric propaganda activity from Miami under Agency direction, also retains strength inside even though its former leaders have been captured and imprisoned. In view of the Latin student's traditional characteristic of resistance to state controls we expect that the DRE can revive quite a few assets for action inside. Its external leadership is presently Manuel SALVAT Roque.

Representatives of these groups say they have formed a National Revolutionary Council (CNR) in Cuba, and many of their representatives have insisted they owe no allegiance to any exile organizations.

Our best estimates of the groups' strength is that they could muster 600 - 700 action agents throughout the island.

I. WELL CONCEIVED

- A. Neo-political Group -- Infiltrate seven men. Recruit, develop and organize resistance, intelligence nets, etc. Underway by mid-November.
- B. Same non-political Group -- Team as above, infiltrate five, operation will be underway subject to weather conditions.
- C. MRR -- Infiltration operation. Deliver 350 pounds demolition. Infiltrate political leader, exfiltrate two others. Underway subject to weather conditions.
- D. UR -- Team composed of internal leader of group plus intelligence coordinator to be infiltrated by 1 December.
- E. Independent group headed by EVELIO DUQUE -- Train five men for group 15th November. Training of operator will proceed currently. First three men of this group will go into Sierra Cristal on or about 20 December.
- F. Another independent group claims contact with OSVALDO RAMIREZ in Escambray, who desires support. We have given guidelines for operations. Calima has 8-10 men with training and have infiltrated general staff.
- G. MRP -- Intend get four people of this group inside by 15 December.
- H. AMHAZERs - Ex MRR - Man with experience along Camaguey coast has feasible plan for establishing mangrove caching facility.

Above is sampling of operations in this category. All above have training W/T, other support facilities, provided or closely supervised by CIA.

II. POORLY CONCEIVED BUT HARMLESS

- A. Rescate -- This group proposed to put in a team to establish contact with internal assets. Group without communications to inside and have operators who refuse to go in blind.
- B. MRP -- Good intentions but their direct proposals, as opposed to those under our direct supervision, repeatedly turned down by us because of bad boats, no W/T, etc.

- C. MDC -- Good place, good intentions, all assets outside, lack militant group inside.

III. POORLY CONCEIVED BUT LETHAL

- A. ORLANDO SPUTO - Proposed to harass a CTC rally in Cuauhtemoc Stadium in Miramar tonight by firing 75 mm high-explosive into stadium fence off score. Told him no dice.
- B. DRE -- Plan to assault BONIATO prison. No specifics. Would be of general interest only under plan of overall liberalization.
- C. White Cross -- Ascaristic approach. Prepare to take any smash and grab operation. High risk factor, high losses.

With this group we are planning operations for Piñar, Matanzas and Las Villas within next six weeks. Leaders of this ~~AMERICA-1~~ AMJAVA-4 and BAZARO will be infiltrated within next six weeks. We are training three radio operators for this group plus two instructors weapons and sabotage. This training will begin by the first of December.

30th of November Group

This covered in WAVE 8743 should all take place by 30th of November. Following that the group will continue in organization and operations. Training of personnel is the same for this group as previous group and applies to all groups.

United Revolucionaria

Plan establishment of three mangrove caching stations. WAVE 8855. Stations will be placed on off-shore caves and receive supplies whenever weather permits. Weather turning bad so must be able to send boats when weather good without requirement for reception committee set up. First one in Camaguey by first of December. Training applies to this group also same as previous. UR boat in Tejana has a 4,000 mile capability and can be made operational within one month. Will give a long range boat with characteristics and speed we need. We feel we should

to shoot and fix this boat. This group has not joined the CRC.

Asociación Revolucionaria del Pueblo - MRD

These people are lagging behind other groups. We don't have a qualified military type to deal with. We are dealing through _____.

We tried to get four people of their's by 15th of December. We did support any operation where our requirements re reception points etc. would permit. ~~RELACIONES EXTERIORES~~ We turned them down last week because they had a bad boat.

Pizcate

This group proposed to put in a team to establish contact with internal assets. Group without communications to inside and have operators who refuse to go in silent. This group has not been effective since AMDIP-3 left. This operation could go within six weeks if we had case officer time.

ANMALE Group

WAVE 8639 - Following this we are planning one in the Santa Clara region - copper in the above extreme west end of Island. Critical communications.

Independent Evelio DUQUE

Train five men for group 15th November. Training of operator will proceed currently. Interested in CW and revise plan to meet present policy requirements. First three men of this group into Sierra Cristal on or about 20 December.

FI Operations

Four operations were submitted by the AMOTS -- COCHISE, APACHE, GERANIMO and one additional without name. First three are all in progress and will be implemented within six weeks. Fourth plan is being studied and can also be implemented within six weeks. CHOCHESE is operations where team going in North coast and they are to set up the dispatch and reception points. HQs. has details for COCHISE, APACHE, AND GERANIMO. The pending operation which can go in six weeks is a team of about three people and they will go in 45 miles east of the CHOCHESE point.

Propaganda

BAUTA

Sabotage plan submitted by the FORD on the BAJA radio station sent up north already. Sent one man in ALICANTE-10 for collection of the necessary information on the area. Plan still in effect.

Plan submitted by the DRE - Assault BONIATO prison. Only considered as possible within general plan of overall liberation but still under consideration.

Not implemented.

Plan for support of clandestine guerrilla forces in volume within the area submitted North. WAVE had no indication from up North re approval or not.

Plan which we put up for the defection of three naval units of Santiago de Cuba with main objective of continued action along coast before retreating to neutral port submitted to DRS. have not considered it and have not sent up against. Considered it feasible in general terms, but can start over again if not in the mode. have to look more thoroughly.

All of these people we are planning general electronic operations - attack electric power, communication, transportation and material delivery, equipment whatever and whenever possible. All are being realized along these lines.

Maritime

Motor vessel M VILARO next six weeks this vessel will begin with full commercial training. After at least one cover voyage used operationally. Can be used with other vessels to supply long range craft. Very slow and we use cautiously. We don't have vessel capability for reaching south coast. TEJANA could do this within four weeks. Proceeding purchase of boat form other side. (Referring to Scotland).

CSIT Team

Team of four people presently capable of maritime recon and operations.

Communications

Presently have six people in training two people will become instructors and (operators) four operational operators. Will have three radios in three weeks, one in three months. ~~EXCELSIOR EXPEDITION~~

For ~~EXC~~ the future we have 33 candidates all of them have had some training. As others move out they will be moved in. Spotted 7 basic candidates prime fly from these groups. With our present staff capable of training six people at one time observing compartmentation. With additional indigenous instructors 10 at any one time with observing compartmentation.

These proposals have not received by FM and we cannot furnish more info
in because of shortage of staff. From BIRN DIRETTORE UR. ANALYST, would
be priority: Recruits, MDC and CPC.

Several groups have come to us offering us boats. There are terrible boats but
they turn away on boats they are inexperienced although they are available.
Less than 5% of these independent operations are most successful. They will
send their boats out in any weather and then want us to pay for repairs. Security
problem of loading boats. It is in the realm of possibility they would be supported
in future, but not until capable crews and good boats.

MEXICO: Next tentative operation proposed by AMWOC-1 - Hire to six fishermen who
have boats here (Miami), Cuban vessels, which can go in and out. We are
investigating this. We have run one operation with this group. It looks good
and we are going to develop.

Another independent, AMCUTLE R-1, he has contact with OSVALDO RAMIREZ in
Escambray who desires support. We have given him guidelines for operations.
Claim he has 6-10 men with training and have infiltrated general staff people.
We are trying to bring him back to group from which he came.

GARCIA BRITO - This group has trained radio operators here and formerly been
in Las Villas. Question of time and lack of communication with internal assets.

Proposed by former AMKAGER, wounded now, experienced along Camaguey coast. Good idea on establishment of mangrove tracking facility. Similar to proposal of UR. They are good group so we're looking into use his know how.

20th of May Group - Have made request for support. Offshoot of 20th of November Group. As a splinter of this group, being advised to rejoin their parent group. Exploring possibility of supporting them if they cannot rejoin parent. Their plans come to us through AMCLATTER-1.

MERC - Requests are same as from other groups, and this is splinter of MRR. We have told them to rejoin parent and provide them general guidelines.

Independent group of camp trainers - 40 mounted supplies and transportation to Oriente. No communications and willing to sacrifice themselves in CW. Given guidelines to forget about CW and get resistance plan. Their spokesman is Fred Goutte.

Independent Group of JUAN MESA - formerly of MDC. Generally collects about four independent boats which he operates as coordinator. Running rescue operations and wants support. For instance, wants support operation to exfiltrate eight children from west coast. Seeking support for an Oriente infiltration team headed by PEPE LOPEZ and 13 men. Turned him down. Didn't Don't have capability to deliver.

Independent cub group headed by ALDO VERA SERAFIN wants training and support of formal cub group. Claims he will hit targets in Havana area. We have not even talked to him on basis of poor CI background. Spokesman is Comte Aguero.

Independent cub group of OSCAR DIAZ wants his previous group. Claim they can hit targets throughout Cuba. Also associated with Comte Aguero. WAVE experience with this man is such that we don't look kindly on this request. As member of FDR military he made things difficult.

Independent group - JULIAN DIAZ FERNANDEZ - Claims to have 300 constitutional army men inside. Radio out here. Willing to go back. WAVE exploring this. Will try to tie him to another group, but if unsuccessful and find his claims valid plan to support him.

ORLANDO SADUTO - proposes to harass a CTC rally in Conquistador Stadium in Miramar tonight by firing 75 mm high-explosive explosive shells into stadium from off shore. Told him no dice.

In addition, the CRC plan at Headquarters hand carried by Bob Davis and given to [redacted] should be included in report. We would like to have it back soon.

One other operation - AMBANTY-I - This man has 300 people in Pinar del Rio. He is being trained and should go back in December
