DYVOUR/PBRUMEN/Operational
C AMSCROLL Mailing Through Latin American Countries

ACTION REQUIRED: FYI

REFERENCE : HRSA - 6706, 16 October 1964

1. The author of the letter reported in reference is AMBLEAK-1 who, in his role as Foreign Affairs Secretary in AMSCROLL, was attempting to expand the indirect mailing capacity of AMSCROLL propaganda to Cuba. Station JMWAVE has encouraged AMSCROLL to contact relatives and friends in the various Latin American countries for assistance in the mailing program so that the postmarks will be diversified in the face of reported Cuban screening and censorship of letters from the JMWAVE area. The attempt to enlist assistance in this effort is undertaken independently by AMSCROLL, that is to say Station JMWAVE does not run checks on individuals contacted until and unless an agreement is reached between them and AMSCROLL. Since it would be difficult for Station JMWAVE to have AMSCROLL back off without creating possible security problems, we would suggest that you direct the recipient of the letter mentioned in reference to decline on some appropriate pretext.

2. Your offer to arrange such assistance through one of the civic action groups to which you have access is much appreciated, but at this point we would like to see whether AMSCROLL's unilateral efforts are sufficient. If not, we might ask later if these facilities are still available.

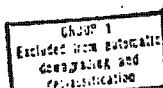

In answer to your request for information on Cuban exile groups we are forwarding herewith the latest issue of the Counterrevolutionary Handbook, and a copy of UFGA - 17592 which transmitted it to Headquarters with an explanation of the method by which it will be updated from time to time. Station San Jose has been added to the list of addressees which will receive amendments as they are produced.
