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QUMALT Defection

It will be recalled that QUMALT/1 defected in Paris in late March 1965, a defection arranged and supervised by [redacted] and was exfiltrated black to [redacted] by air immediately following the surfsing press conference.

UNBOUND queried us on the case immediately thereafter and pressed the [redacted] for an admission that KIBARK had played a part in QUMALT/1's defection and, especially, his trip from France to [redacted]. We at first pleaded ignorance but on 7 April, BULLIEH presented UNBOUND/11 with the agreed upon cover story that QUMALT/1 had made his own way to [redacted] with false Latin American passports.

To sum it up, UNBOUND appeared to unhappily accept this cover story but probably did not believe it. BULLIEH opined that either UNBOUND knew the truth of the matter, via penetrations -human or technical- of KIBARK offices or residences, which UNBOUND certainly could not admit; or, they simply suspected that we were involved.

The current surfsing of QUMALT/1 name as connected with the ANLASH affair will almost certainly confirm to UNBOUND what they knew or suspected - that KIBARK was involved with QUMALT/1 at the time of his defection. Whether or not they can prove that [redacted] exfiltrated QUMALT/1 black from France is another question. In any event, they will know (if they believe the press concerning the ANLASH case) that we lied to them in March/April 1965.

Other revelations

Manuel Mirales Mendez

We know (from USNAFU/9) that the French were (in 1964) interested in ANLASH/1 since they queried USNAFU/9 at least once about ANLASH/1 and knew that he was in the country. They were probably also aware of ANWRIP/1's trips to France and, by comparing timing, would discover the probable connection between ANLASH/1 and ANWRIP/1. Also, USNAFU/8 has always been considered as an UNBOUND or UNION informant and USNAFU/8 was aware of ANLASH/1 in Paris and of ANLASH/1's connections with USNAFU/9, ANWRIP/1, and, probably, ANLASH/2 and 3. USNAFU/8 may have kept tabs on ANLASH/1 on behalf of the French since as early as 1962/3. This, however, is only speculation.

As a final note, I mention that I surfaced the name of USNAFU/9 as a Cuban acquaintance to the UNBOUND official who interviewed me in July 1965.
