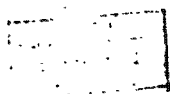
**SUBJECT: AMMUG/1 Debriefing Report #277
(FNU) JORRIN/Photographic Surveillance of Cuban
Consulate, Mexico City**

1. On 9 February 1965, AMMUG/1 identified a photograph of (FNU) JORRIN, the "portero" (gatekeeper) at the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City. JORRIN is a Cuban.
2. This photograph is part of the surveillance on the Cuban Consulate in Mexico City and was taken from Film No. 324, Photo 5, dated 22 January 1964. JORRIN is the individual on the right hand side of the print and has a receding hairline.
3. WH/C/RR/OS Comment: The above is probably identifiable with Heberto JORRIN Munoz (201-732870).
