<p>1. At WAVE's direction, AMICE-14 sent inquiries to the Law faculties of the following Latin-American universities in mid-September 1964: Universidad de Chile; Universidad Nacional de Buenos Aires; Universidad de la Republica Oriental del Uruguay; and Universidad Central de Venezuela. As of 31 October 1964, he had received replies from Venezuela, Uruguay and Chile, all of which sounded promising. It appeared from the above replies that AMICE-14 should have little difficulty in gaining admission to any of these universities.</p> <p>2. To the best of WAVE's knowledge, all of the above universities begin the next school year in March 1965 with the exception of the University of Venezuela which commences in September and extends through July. With only about four months remaining prior to entry date at the rest of the schools, a great deal of planning and coordination both at JMWAVE and in Latin-America must be accomplished to prepare and stage any transfer for AMICE-14. In view of the pressing time limitation, it is requested that those addressees who have not responded to referenced dispatch indicate their interest in the possible utilization of AMICE-14 in their respective areas. At the same time, WAVE encourages all addressees to forward any current or foreseen difficulties concerning AMICE-14's usage which WAVE may be in a position to clarify or remove.</p> <p>3. For COS, (Buenos Aires), JMWAVE appreciates the thoughtful response from your Station to referenced dispatch.</p>
