1. AMICE-14, as described in Reference, definitely appears uniquely qualified, and with his previous training, should be considered a a highly competent agent		
for clandestine activities. The Station would more than welcome A-14 as an agent		
of the Station if it appeared that there was any possibility of using him in student activities as described in Reference.		
2. The Station has no going operations, in the student field in which A-la		
could be used at this time. Apart from the FURANKFUPT Project (mainly concerned		
with Christian Democratic Nouth) and (FUBLAS-1 s dealings with dissident elements of the Radical Youth, the Station has beveral developing contacts in democratic		
type student leaders. Since A-14 would obviously be unsuited for infiltrating		
Communist or pro-Castro groups, the Station believes any prospects for student type operations involving A-14 would probably have to start from scratch and be a		
developmental type operation. Given A-14 a necessity for careful handling, per para-		
graph 7 of attachment - of Reference, the Station feels that A-14 night reject or be discontent with developing student operations. Being a sun of action, even the		
general Chilean political climate and operational conditions would probably not appeal to A-14.		
3. Station agrees with the statement in paragraph 9 of attachment 4 of Reference "the biggest challenge is to find a way to continue to utilize his talents". While		
the Station recognizes the fact that A-14 would be an asset for the Station, we are unable to place him in a going student operation. Any developmental type operation		
involving A-14 would have to be on a triel basis with no positive guarantee of its		
success or continuance. Only on this basis could the Station justify the assignment of A-la to Chile.)
