Mexican wisa No. 1334 issued in Habana on 2 April 1956.

Cuban reentry percit issued in Habana on 10 April 1956.

- b. GUIR matriculated at the University of Habana School of Sugar and Agricultural Economy during the 1955-56 Adademic year, capraing registration card No. 7-384 issued 5 March 1956.
- c. Cuban drivers jermit No. 305715 was issued in Nabana on 11 October 1953.
