SUBJECT GENERAL Operational
SPECIFIC Ramon Tomas GUIN Dias

1. Subject, a Cuban exile, is currently residing in San José and has applied to the US Consulate for an immigrant visa to the U.S.
2. The following data were extracted from his visa application papers and accompanying documents:
 - a. Cuban passport No. 24386 issued in Habana on 13 November 1952. Visas and travel recorded in his passport are:
 - U.S. non-immigrant visa No. 14035 issued in Habana on 13 November 1952. Entered U.S. through Key West, Florida twice - on 15 November 1952 and 7 June 1954.
 - Costa Rican entry permit issued 11 June 1956.
 - Costa Rican exit permit for Panama No. 162805 issued 19 September 1956 in San José.
 - Mexican visa No. 1334 issued in Habana on 2 April 1956.
 - Cuban exit permits issued in Habana on 12 January 1955, 20 March 1955, and 29 May 1956.
 - Cuban reentry permit issued in Habana on 10 April 1956.
 - b. GUIN matriculated at the University of Habana School of Sugar and Agricultural Economy during the 1955-56 Academic year, carrying registration card No. F-384 issued 5 March 1956.
 - c. Cuban drivers permit No. 305715 was issued in Habana on 11 October 1953.
 - d. Cuban National Police "no derogatory background clearance" was issued 30 October 1956, listing his Habana address as Calle de Concordia No. 716, Central Zone. The Cuban Ministry of Justice issued a no criminal record clearance dated 29 October 1956.
 - e. Costa Rican Registro Civil clearance No. R-277684 was issued in San José on 7 November 1956.

- f. An affidavit of support was provided from GUIN's uncle by marriage, Juan SOTO, 164 Ellery Street, Brooklyn, New York, dated 9 October 1956. Subject is planning on an indefinite period of residence in the U.S., where he will work and study.
- g. Personal data: Born in Habana 22 September 1933, the son of Ramon GUIN Hernandez and Amalia DIAZ Gonzalez, residing at Concordia 716, altos, Habana; both Cuban citizens. GUIN is single, speaks only Spanish. He was arrested in Habana on 4 August 1955 (presumably for revolutionary activities). San José address is Avenida 6, No. 643 Oeste, Apartado 3019; no telephone (relative's house). Description: 5' 10", white, brown eyes and hair.
- h. A copy of Subject's visa picture is attached.
3. The San Jose Apartado directory lists Apartado 3019 as belonging to Antonio Acillo MONTES (possibly MONTES). Station files contain no reference to either name.
