1. Pursuant to your request contained in your memorandum of 28 January 1953, Special Agent James A. SPRIGUE contacted Mr. Paul PAXTON, Operations Officer FI/WH at his office, Room 1112 Quarters "Eye" on 28 January 1953 and advised him of the pending interview of the Subject by the F.B.I.

2. PAXTON stated that there was no objection on the part of WH to the Subject being interviewed in the same manner as on previous occasions. PAXTON was informed that the testimony of the Subject before the Subversive Activities Control Board may be required sometime in the future but it was hoped that the pending interview would negate the necessity of such testimony.

3. PAXTON inquired as to whether I&S desired the Chief of Station in Panama to be informed of the contemplated interview. Upon being advised that such notification was a matter for WH decision, PAXTON stated that he would take whatever action ^{he} considered necessary.
