 contacts in Cuban emigre circles in the Miami, Florida area:

The Movimiento Revolucionario del Pueblo (MRP) has established a military training camp on a farm located at Bauer Drive, Homestead, Florida, and about four blocks from a farm owned by Mario V'Squez. The following members of the MRP reportedly were receiving training:
