2. FIDEL CASTRO WAS PERSONALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SHOOTING DOWN OF AN AMERICAN U-2 PLANE AT THE HEIGHT OF THE OCTOBER 62 CUBAN CRISIS. CASTRO APPROACHED THE SOVIET COMMANDER OF A SAM EMPLACEMENT OR SAMEDETACHMENT AND HARANGUED HIM ABOUT THE "IMPOSSIBILITY" OF PERMITTING U.S. PLANES TO PHOTOGRAPH CUBA.
