## MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Contact with Department of Justice

On 4 November 1975 I was called by Mr. Ron Malone (phone 187 - 4637), one of the three people from the Department of Justice who were briefed on CI Project matters by Mr. [redacted] and me. Before returning his call, I checked with Mr. [redacted] office (he was on a TDY) and 03 (Mr. O'Reilly), CI/EXO. (Mr. O'Reilly) instructed me to refer Mr. Malone to Mr. Waller. I called Mr. Waller to advise him, and was instructed to carry on with the original briefing if that was what Mr. Malone wanted. When I returned Mr. Malone's call, he told me that the "file" on Lee Harvey Oswald had "escaped" them. (I assume that this means they have misplaced their notes on Oswald.) Ms Hope Byrne (spelling?) would be in HQS that afternoon, and would like to see the file again. I told Mr. Malone to have her contact (Mr. O'Reilly), and I so informed (Mr. O'Reilly). 03
