RE TELEPHONE CALL FROM ASSISTANT DIRECTOR W. C. SULLIVAN THIS AFTERNOON. RFP

TWINSTON SCOTT! HEAD OF CIA OFFICE HERE, JUST ADVISED RECEIPT OF CABLE FROM HIS HEADQUARTERS FURNISHING INFO RE POLYGRAPH OPERATOR. SCOTT STATED HIS CABLE FURNISHED DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS TO EFFECT CUSTODY OF (ALVARADO) SHOULD BE OBTAINED FROM MEXICANS, THAT (ALVARADO) SHOULD BE FED AND GIVEN A CHANCE TO REST AND THAT INTERVIEW SHOULD BE CONDUCTED ONLY IN PRESENCE OF POLYGRAPH OPERATOR AND THE WRITER. SCOTT SAID HIS CABLE INDICATED THAT THIS SHOULD BE DONE BECAUSE IT MIGHT BE NECESSARY FOR WRITER TO TRAVEL TO WASHINGTON TO REPORT ON RESULTS OF INTERVIEW.

IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING CALL FROM MR. SULLIVAN THIS OFFICE TOOK INITIAL STEPS TO STOP DEPORTATION OF (ALVARADO) TO NICARAGUA WHICH WAS SCHEDULED FOR 8 AM TOMORROW. SINCE SCOTT ORIGINALLY HANDLED TURNING OVER TO MEXICANS OF (ALVARADO) WHO WAS UNDER CIA CONTROL, HE TONIGHT IS TAKING UP MATTER OF POLYGRAPH TEST OF (ALVARADO) WITH [LAUS ECHEVERRIA] ACTING MINISTER OF GOBERNACION, TO ASCERTAIN WHETEER MEXICANS WILLIES TO RELEASE (ALVARADO) FOR TEST. POSSIBILITY ALWAYS EXISTS THAT MEX CANS MAY FEEL THEIR NATIONAL SOVEREIGNTY BEING INVADED AND THEY MAY INSIST ON HAVING ONE OR MORE OBSERVERS PRESENT DURING TEST.
