1. DURING THE LATTER PART OF MARCH 1966 JUAN JOSE  
 PERUYERO RODRIGUEZ, PRESIDENT OF THE ASSOCIATION OF THE  
VETERANS OF THE BAY OF PIGS (BRIGADE 2506) SAID THAT THE  
ASSOCIATION HAD INFILTRATED ONE OF ITS MEMBERS INTO CUBA  
ABOUT THE FIRST PART OF FEBRUARY WITH THE MISSION OF  
ASSASSINATING FIDEL CASTRO RUZ.

2. THE NAME OF THE INFILTRATED MEMBER IS NOT KNOWN,  
 THE INFILTRATEE TOOK WITH HIM A CART SIMILAR TO AN ICE CREAM  
 CART AND WILL POSE AS A STREET VENDOR OF SOME SORT FOR

PURPOSES OF CARRYING OUT THE ASSASSINATION.

3. THE ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT <sup>APR 22 3 30 PM '66</sup> HAS BEEN SCHEDULED FOR 17 OR 18 APRIL, A DAY ON WHICH FIDEL CASTRO IS SCHEDULED TO MAKE A SPEECH. (FIELD COMMENT: FIDEL CASTRO IN THE PAST HAS MADE A SPEECH ON ABOUT THIS DATE TO COMMEMORATE THE CUBAN VICTORY AT THE BAY OF PIGS. THIS YEAR WILL HOLD SPECIAL SIGNIFICANCE AS IT IS THE FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE VICTORY).
