SQUIB/Request For Release of Warren Commission Document

ACTION REQUIRED - REFERENCES

- 1. WOFIRM has been requested by an Australian newspaper editor (Attachment A) to release the Warren Commission Document STA (CD 371) is Attachment B) which relates to anonymous telephone calls to the Canberra Embassy at the time of the assassination of President Kennedy. His request was turned down. As you probably know, there has been mounting public pressure to release classified documents of the Warren Commission. While no decision has been made to declassify (CD 371), it is highly possible we will be asked to do so in the near future by National Archives, which has official custody of the documents, or by some higher authority.
- 2. Melbourne Station is requested to discuss Paragraph One above with SCUIB/1 afterhis return to Australia. The SCUIB service is mentioned in Paragraph 4 of CD 971 and release of the document is certain to provoke questions in Australia. Since CD 971 is a U. S. Government document we need not (and should not) request SCUIB concurrence for release of the document. He should be informed, however, that release of CD 971 to the public domain is presently under consideration; that the United States Navy has no objections; and that we are giving him advance notice as a matter of courtesy. Any views volunteered by SCUIB/1 regarding this release should be reported promptly to Headquarters.
