Intelligence Agency

1. This Office has recently received a copy of a complaint filed on 26 June 1975, against the Department of Defense and this Agency in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of New York by Eugene B. Dinkin. Mr. Dinkin is seeking damages based upon a belief that a Warren Commission document (No. 943) entitled "Allegations of PFC Eugene Dinkin re: Assassination Plot" is a misrepresentation by CIA and DOD of the facts surrounding his assertion in 1963 of prior knowledge of the assassination of President Kennedy.

Re OGC request concerning DINKIN (OGC 75-2491) - on 16 July I received the attached transmittal slip from OGC, asking C/CI/IS to act for the DDO. I passed the request to Paul Hartman on 18 July, and he and I prepared a response the same date (CI 155-75). This package was misplaced in one of my safes. On 30 July there is a note to the effect that CI/EXO was handling the matter for CI Staff. On 29 August, Diana Porter recorded the following:

"CI/EXO office called saying they had had an inquiry regarding OGC case #75-2491 (DINKIN) stating that CI Staff was only component still outstanding on this request. I took our completed file to CI/EXO, which indicated CI/EXO was office of control. CI/EXO remembered case and is checking his records and will reply to OGC."

There is no record of any reply from CI/EXO in our files, so I do not know whether the five documents attached to CI 155-75 were in fact passed.
