FBI Bequest for Polygraph Test of Vexican

Ylardo ROJAS

- 1. On 31 December 1963 a Maxican from Chedalajara named X Ylario ROJAS wrote to Attorney General Robert Kennedy, White Rouse, saying he had known Lee OSWALD in Mexico. Follow-up integrogation by the FBI in Mexico produced the claim from ROJAS that he had seen CSWALD on the Yesten Island of Cozumel. He said that CSWAID was there in the company of Cubens and also connected with an American official named Albert (Imu).
 - 2. FDI investigation of the story shows many flaws, and fabrication is certainly indicated, but no confession has been obtained. The FBI in Mexico and Washington have both officially requested help from us in polygraphing ROJAS. The FSI has few polygraph operators and does not make much use of the device.

3. I have conferred with Mr. Popich of the MI, Mr. O'Meal of the CI Staff, and Mesers. Howard Ophorne and sboat the problem. We end Security do not went to test FOUAS in Wexico because he is a Mexican citizen and we have no control over him; he could screen to the press and emberrass us. This could be avoided by enlisting the aid of Mexican authorities, but Security does not want to do this because it would identify their operator, Mr. Calvin Davis, to the Mexicons. Mr. Davis is the man regularly sent secretly to Maxico to test our can agents, and we do not want to blow him. The FBI has offered to bring ROJAS to Texas for us to polygraph and we and security egree this would be fine. Ar. Osborne thinks we should get the permission of the Director to do this.

4. We request that you consider this issue and, if you egree that we should do it and that the Director's permission is needed, you obtain it.
