MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: Gilbert Policarpo Lopez

1. On 19 March 1964, an agent of the Federal Judicial Police informed the CIA Base in Monterrey, Mexico, that "one of his contacts" reported in late February 1964 that Subject was involved in the Kennedy assassination. The details were cabled to CIA Headquarters by the Monterrey Base via MNTY 0829 (attached).

2. A member of the Inspector General Task Force interviewed Mr. [redacted], the Chief of Base, Monterrey at that time, with reference to the substance of the cable. After perusal of the cable, Mr. [redacted] stated that he had absolutely no recollection of the substance contained in the cable and that he had not originated it. The record shows that Mr. Alan White, now retired, was the author and sole signator of the cable.
