Disposition - This document was denied. The document is based on information received from a lougign security service which it obtained from a (sensitive intelligence operation run by that service) The information is concerned with the attempt of an American to contact the Cuban Embassy in a foreign city. The reason for this attempted contact apparently had to do with an interest in obtaining a visa for a visit to Cuba. The individual involved was never found to have any involvement in assassination plans or activities. The document also contained information confirming the existence of an Agency station in a specific city abroad, information confirming aliaison arrangement with a foreign seconity service, as well as information identifying the kind of intelligence operation which produced his particular information. Given the data to identify the kind of operation, the specific source of the operation would also be evident. Both matters are considered sensitive by the foreign service which provided the information. Those factors required that the information continue to be handled as classified. This particular document also identifies a number of Agency components and several Agency staff employees. The document was denied under the authority of exemptions (b)(1), (b)(3) and (b)(6).
