

1. Reference is made to a communication from your Bureau dated 23 August 1964.

2. This Agency has received the following information on subject from a source who is considered unreliable. Mr. Martin Luther KING met with various leaders of the Italian Communist Party (PCI) and of the Italian Socialist Party (PSI) on 18 September 1964 in Rome. He discussed with these Italian politicians the program of demonstrations against segregation in the United States which are to be organized in Italy during the months immediately ahead. Mr. KING reportedly conferred with PCI Senators Vito SANTO and Ugo MARTELLI, with PSI Senator Paolo VITALELLI, and with Deputy Leader Lucio MUZZATO of the Italian Socialist Party of Proletarian Unity (PSIUP).

Senators VELIO SAVO and G. LAFAMAGNA, with PSI Senator Paolo  
VITTORI, and with Deputy Lucio RUSSO of the Italian Socialist  
Party of Proletarian Unity (PSIP).
