- 1. A usually reliable and sensitive source reports that on 15 June 1965 an unidentified wearn speaking French called Josquin HERNAHDEZ Arms, Cuban Ambassador to Mexico, from Chicago. The woman stated she was calling on behalf of a Mr. GAN (phonetic); she asked whether Silvia DURAH was a friend of Harvey Lee GWALD, and if DURAH had returned to Cuba. The Ambassador, who does not understand such French, said that DURAH used to work at the Embassy, no longer does, and that she resides in Mexico but he does not know the address. The woman again asked if DURAH was a friend of CSWALD. The Ambassador, who appeared not to understand the question fully, answered affirmatively.
