- 1. As your Eurom is aware, the Clandostine Services is developing a machine colletion program to handle information on the Cuban intelligence and security services. As yet, the data base is very nerrow, with the result that any search against the program has a very limited chance of success. Honotheless, a search was made using those items of information which are known relating to the two letters from Havens, one dated 10 Havenber 1963 and addressed to Oswald, and the other dated 27 Havenber 1963 and addressed to the Attorney General.
- 2. The assumptions on which the search were made were: that the writer was using elements of a true name (for example, that his true first name was Mario, or Fedro or Charles or Feder); and that the writer was connected in some way with Havens and Missi. The print-out listed 19 names, of which only two seemed to hold any interest. A review of the files on these two eliminated one, leaving a single condidate.
- 3. It must be emphasized that there is no reason to believe that this man is in fact the writer of the letters except for what may in fact prove to be more coincidences in first names and in locations; and further that the assumptions on which these similarities are based may themselves be false. Homelbeless, the identity of this single possible condidate is being furnished your Eureau for whatever use is deemed expropriate.
- 4. The individual is <u>Pedro Mario PALMERO-HERNAMBEZ</u>, on whom your Bureau has reported under Internal Security Cuba, and Registration Act Cuba (Mismi Field Office File \$105-2343, Bureau File \$105-35178). A copy of CSCI-3/762,398, 28 October 1960, to the Immigration and Maturalization Service, is attached.
