SUBJECT

Assessination of Provident John F. Rennedy

- 1. In the course of our reserved of files portaining to areas of the USSR in which Law Harvey GSWALD ellegedly resided, a photograph of an individual closely resembling GSWALD was uncovered.
- 5. Our files indicate that this photograph (Attachment A) came from a color transparency taken in Munic, USEL, on or about 11 August 1961, by an American tourist, Mrs. Munica F. ERAMER, whose address at the time was P. O. Box 986, Solvang, California.
- Ploshchad' (Central Square), which is located in the center of Minsk. The building in the background has been identified as The Palace of Culture. Six people are depicted in the photograph. The individual second from the right, appears to be Lee Harvey OSWALD. It should be noted that the shirt this individual is wearing appears to be identical to the shirt OSWALD is wearing in two photographs from the group of 47 photographs from the effects of OSWALD which were forwarded to this Agency in your communication of I hearth 1964, file number (S) 105-82555, subject: Assassization of Fresident John F. KENNEDY. Copies of these two photographs of OSWALD are forwarded with this report as Attachment B.
- 4. Source of the photograph identified one of the females in the picture, possibly the one on the left, as Svetlans (LNU), an interist guide. Source was accompanied by another American, Miss Rita NAMAN, 595 Atlandes

Road, Solvang, California, who is possibly the female second from the left in the photograph. None of the other individuals can be further identified.

- 5. Mrs. ERAMER and Miss NAMAN, both of whom are United States citizens, were contacted by this Agency on a con-time basis, following their return from their tour of the USSK. The report of this contact, CO-B-1,212,967, dated 21 March 1962, subject: Realities/Titor Farade/Interrogation in Minch Pollowing the Giving Away of a US News Magazine, is forwarded as Atlackment C.
- 6. hers. ERAMER, who is described as "an older companion" in the source description of Attachment C, furnished this Agency with 160 color transparencies taken during the trip. Attachment A is only one of the five transparencies of which negative copies were made and retained by this Agency. All of the 160 original color transparencies were returned to live. ERAMER.
- 7. Miss NAMAN, referred to as "a college graduate" in the source description of Attachment C. provided this Agency with one reel of from color movie film taken during the trip. The film was viewed by this Agency and was subsequently returned to Miss NAMAN.
- 6. This Agency has had no further contact with either Mrs. KRAMER or Miss MAMAN subsequent to the contact reflected in the report forwarded as Attachment C.
- 9. This office would be interested in may pertinent information which interviews of Mrs. KRAMER and Miss MAMAN by year office relight possibly provide along the following lines:
 - a. A more positive identification of the individual in Attachment A tentatively identified as OSWALD.
 - b. The exact date and estimate of the time of day when the photograph (Affachment A) was taken.
