a 33 year old Cuban male refuzee was first . In in our clinic on October 14, 1965 with the history of having emosphalitis at the age of 3, having seizures at the age of 12, buing troated with modication, doing well until 1958 when he was buaten by the Batista police. From that time on he had 4 or 5 cultures a month, fought in the Bay of Pigs, escaped from Cuba, and was troated in the United States at Mercy Hospital.

"His seizures continued and in 1964 removal of a focal epileptic Toows from his Right Corobral Hemisphere was done in Kemphis. Since that time has been on Dilantin, Fhenobarbital, and Myseline, totook modications irregularly and had frequent seizures. Since that time he has been repeatedly seen in clinic, and we have tried to bring his scieures under control by getting him to take his middle for rogularly. At the present time we are still trying to regulate his medication. He has 2 to 3 seigures per month.
