



B. LEE HARVEY OSWALD

OSWALD came to the attention of KGB when he expressed a wish to defect to the USSR shortly after his arrival in Russia. The KEB after inquiry decided he was mentally unstable and informed him he had to return to the United States upon completion of his visit. Thereafter, when OSWALD missed a sightseeing tour he was to take, his hotel room was forced open and he was found with one of his wrists badly cut. NOSENKO said if he had been found ten minutes later, OSWALD would have been dead. The KGB wanted nothing to do with OSWALD, but he was allowed to remain in Russia, apparently through the efforts of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Red Cross. OSWALD again came to the attention of KGB when he attempted to re-enter the USSR by placing a request with the Soviet Embassy in Mexico, after his return to the United States. Again the KGB recommended again his being allowed into Russia. NOSENKO said OSWALD's case was a routine one in which the KGB had no interest until he assassinated President KENNEDY. was not approached or recruited for espionage by the KGB nor was his wife MARINA. NOSENKO said MARINA was regarded as having little intelligence. She had once been a member of the Komsomol, but had been dropped for failure over a long period of time to pay her dues.
