Enclosed is a copy of a letter dated 4/7/69 addressed to Mr. Nathan B. Lenvin, Chief, Foreign Agents Registration Section, Department of Justice, and written over the signature of Stephen Fischer-Galati on the stationery of the University of Colorado. Also enclosed is a copy of the report of SA Daniel J. Griffin dated 8/31/60 at Boston concerning subject.

Nathan B. Lenvin, now deceased, according to Bufiles interviewed Fischer-Galati in 1956 in connection with a matter in which Fischer-Galati was to testify. The enclosures are furnished for your assistance in the event any information is brought to your attention concerning the matter in the enclosed letter. Fischer-Galati should not be interviewed without prior Bureau authority; however, in the event he contacts your office, any information offered should be accepted and furnished to the Bureau.

Bufiles contain no information which would indicate that subject could be involuntarily leaving the U.S. as indicated in the enclosed letter.
