Fischer-Galati previously wrote to the Vice President concerning the disappearance of kiha, which letter was referred to the Eureau for reply. He was informed the FBI had conducted no investigation concerning the disappearance of Riha; had no information regarding his whereabouts and there was no indication of a violation of Federal law within the FBI's jurisdiction.

Fischer-Galati is a professor of history, Colorado University. Salutation of Dr. taken from established reference book. According to Bufiles, Fischer-Galati was deferred in World War II for psychoneurosis, anxiety type. He reportedly advised State Department in 1950 he was a close friend of the Director's, an untrue statement. He has been in periodic routine contact in the past with the Romanian Embassy and contacts not of known security significance. He was born in Romania.

Ile communicated with Justice Department 4/7/69 concorning Riha's disappearance. Justice acknowledged his lotter. He has been mentioned in several press items in the Riha case as an acquaintance and University associate.
