CANADA

A reliable source has advised that on February 11, 1972 P.R.C. Embassy officials in Ottawa contacted Susan WARREN, New York and requested her to come to the Embassy in Ottawa. According to source, WARREN was committed to speaking engagements in the U.S. on February 16/17, 1972, however expected to be in Ottawa during the weekend of February 20, 1972.

2. Source later learned that WARREN arranged to visit the Embassy on February 26, 1972. Source had no indication as to the purpose of the proposed meeting and is unable to confirm that WARREN visited the Embassy as planned.
