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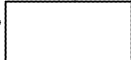

EMBARRASSING TO THE CHILEAN GOVERNMENT AND THE CHILEAN GOVERNMENT

IS EXTREMELY RELUCTANT AND WILL BE ADAMANT IN DISCLOSING ANY CONNEC-
