These photographs are of material in their baggage which was left in their hotel room between 9/30/59 and 10/4/59 while they were visiting London. It is noted that these photographs contain addresses from an address book, addresses from what appears to be a calendar, press cards in possession of subjects, notes pertaining to business contacts and one page which appears to be a personal code. Also photographed was a map of Pittaburg with several crosses at various locations. The significance of these marks is not known, but this may be of interest to the Bureau. These photographs are being forwarded to the Bureau for review and any further investigation deemed advisable by the Bureau.

JOHN PITTMAN and his wife and children registered at the Notel Callie, he rue de l'Arcade, Paris, on 9/24/59. They departed on the evening of 9/30/59 for London. They returned from London on 10/4/59 and returned to the Notel Callic. They left Paris finally on 10/6/59 by air for Moscow.

The Soviet diplomat IOUMI ZOUMY, an Attache of the Soviet Imbassy, Paris, personally handled the visa applications for PITTMH and his family and delivered to PITTMH the visas necessary to enable them to travel to Moscow.

During his visit to Paris, PITTMAN received a visitor, an American negro by the name of ELLINGTON, whose exact identity is unknown. He also telephoned a French Communist newspaper reporter MARCEL PREFECEILLE. (C)
