During March, 1962, BROWN continued to interview a large number of Cuban nationals and initiated contact with Americans interested in anti-Communism. BROWN also contacted thet John Birch Society and other extreme groups for the purpose of obtaining help for Cuban nationals and soliciting their aid in fighting Communism., BROWN later returned to Boulder, Colorado; and on about June 21, 1962, sent a clipping from the "Denver Post! containing the article he wrote entitled "Cuban Exiles Have Learned, to Hate CIA".
