Re New York letter to the Bureau dated 3/1/65, and Mexico City airtel dated 6/3/64, captioned "HAYWOOD HALL, aka, SLOKKS SM - C; GWENDOLYN CHARMAGNE HALL, aka, SM - C."

On 6/2/65, Mexico City Station of CIA, advised that the Mexico City Station of CIA had developed no information that the New China News Agency has furnished funds either to the subject, the Progressive Labor Movement in the United States, or to FREDERICK VANDERBILT FIELD (Bufile 100-2278) in Mexico City.

Logical sources available to Legat, Mexico, have been alerted to the possibility that Red Chinese funds are being furnished to the subject or to the Progressive Labor Movement in the United States and to date no information has been developed regarding this.

Both the Mexico City Station of CIA and sources available to Legat, Mexico, will continue to be alert to funds movement from the New China News Agency to the United States

On Page 2 of referenced Mexico City airtel Rex-MEX-1 and ex-MEX-19 who have furnished reliable information in the past, advised as follows on 4/10/64:(4)

According to ELIZABETH MORA (Bufile 100-395394), the Progressive Labor Movement was receiving \$1,300 from the Chinese Communists to print HAYWOOD HALL'S (Bufile 100-14017) book. MORA also claimed that VINCENT THEODORE LEE (Bufile 105-96362), who was formerly head of the Aid to Cuba group, was then heading a revolutionary aid committee which she believed was called "Aid to Supporters of Democratic Revolution"
