Re Mexico City airgram 9/12/57 advising Bureau of
subject's alleged return to Mexico City and hospitalization.

A pretext telephone call to the subject's residence
at Calle Country Club No. 67, Mexico, D. F., developed
information to the effect that he is not yet at home but is
expected within a few days.

On 11/27/57 [redacted] (s) THOMAS J. HAZLETT
advised that BAYO was still hospitalized at the Spanish
Hospital in Mexico City but was much improved and should be
released within the near future. He further stated that he
had received unconfirmed information to the effect that subject
had been contacted by JUAN JOSE MEZA, Nicaraguan revolutionary
leader in Mexico City, in behalf of MANUEL GOMEZ FLORES, with
a request that BAYO join the latter in Central America in
order to assist him with training troops for a projected
military action against the current Nicaraguan government.

This office will endeavor to determine further in-
formation concerning BAYO's release from the hospital and
his movements and will report with respect thereto.
