-ADMINISTRATIVE-

The CIA letter of reference advised of 17 individuals, but listed only 16 by name, who were to have participated in the Cuban invasion attempt but who for disciplinary reasons were unable to do so. $(\mathfrak{G})(\mathcal{U})$

On May 10, 1961, CIA, Miami, delivered a similar list to the Miami Office and the seventeenth individual was noted as MARTIN TORRES FORTE, not further identified.

According to CIA Agent Miami, these seventeen individuals were kept in the guard house at the training camp in Guatemala as disciplinary cases of routine army nature and were not suspected of pro-CASTRO activities.

Miami file review on the seventeen individuals (x) (4) reflected background data on several, generally from INS, Miami, re Cuban political refugees entering the United States.

The only one of the 17 individuals identified from Miami files as an alleged CASTRO agent was RICARDO MARTINEZ DE LA CRUZ.
