By "Top Secret" communication dated August 30, 1955, the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) advised that the subject was scheduled to depart for the United States on August 30, 1955, from the Philippine Islands as one of a group of twelve Philippine labor leaders who will undergo labor training under the sponsorship of the International Cooperation Administration (ICA). Esguerra will remain in this country for approximately six months. According to CIA,
