PCI SETH WARD STONE advised in May, 1954 that ~~ORVILLE LINDSEY CHAMBLESS~~ is again hauling whiskey for ~~RED HOLT~~.

PCI CUSTER SCOTT HALE of known reliability advised in May, 1954 that ~~GUY TINES~~, a well known safe cracker, was residing at 318 N.E. 7th Street, Oklahoma City.

FRANK MASSAD, Oklahoma City criminal lawyer, is reported in new trouble resulting from an altercation with his wife, according to the Daily Oklahoman 5/26/54.
