Former SA William K. Harvey telephonically contacted the Liaison Section on February 17, 1950 and advised that personnel of the Office of Special Operations, CIA, were interested in obtaining information concerning the above-captioned insurance fund. Harvey advised that he and former SA [redacted] desired to start such a fund for the personnel of their agency. (S)

Harvey seemed particularly interested in obtaining information concerning the amount of funds maintained on hand in proportion to the number of agents interested in the fund. He also desired to ascertain what legal technicalities must be handled before such a fund can be initiated. (Au)

Harvey was advised that his request would be brought to the attention of the Chief Clerk's Office and that if such information was available to outside agencies he would be given an answer accordingly. (Au)
