He related he has, from time to time, furnished information which he considered to be of value to the U. S. Immigration Service, U. S. Secret Service, U. S. Customs Agency, and the FBI in New York City. OLEA is referred to in New York airtel dated September 30, 1965, (NY File 15-36970) (MM File 15-4762). He further advised that approximately ten months ago he received \$100.00 from the U. S. Secret Service in connection with an investigation involving the sale of gold.
