August 1957 to(5) summer 1960 accredited to the United Nations Headquarters in New(s) York City with the rank of Ambassador as an Alternate Permanent Delegate. During his New York City tenure, he was known to write(5) bank drafts to persons known to be active Communist workers. It was suggested that he was used as a means of financing Communist Party activities He appears to be a Soviet contact, and that his wife, one 🥖 Tamara Spinosa, nee Pechkurova, native Russian S was reported to have been an agent of the Soviet security services. She was admitted to Mexico in September 1947. When Espinosa y Prieto was in Mexico, he was in close touch with the(5) Soviet Embassy and expedited visas for Soviet delegations. The couple were particularly friendly with Soviet Ambassador Kapustin during 1953. [Mrs. Espinosa's brother died in a Soviet prison in 1953, and (5) her mother still resides in the USSR.
