CIA in its letter furnished data concerning subject which it received from (S) [redacted] We have previously been in possession of these data. CIA indicated it was interested in learning if subject's position at the UN dealt with the Cong/o. CIA also indicated it would appreciate receipt of any Bureau information on subject that could be passed by CIA to [redacted] Upon receipt of data from CIA as to what is desired to be passed, a decision will be made as to whether CIA or our Legat, Madrid, should pass the information.
